### **Rules for the nomination of Executive Committee members**

(6e) Nominations for the election of members of the Executive Committee shall be in writing and shall be delivered to the Secretary at least two weeks before the date of the Annual Meeting. Such nominations shall be supported by a proposer and a seconder and shall have the written consent of the nominee endorsed on the proposal form. Nominations shall only be valid if at the date of the nomination the nominee and his/her proposer and seconder are all paid-up members of the Society.

(6c) At each Annual General Meeting every Committee member who has held office for three years since his/her last election shall retire from office and be eligible for re-election.

Please note that at each AGM a maximum of six persons shall be elected to the Executive Committee (6d).
